Poetry Contest

Eligibility

- 1. Any 4-H member meeting general eligibility rules.
- 2. Limit 2 participants in each age group per county.

General Rules

- 1. Poems may be original poems or obtained from a book.
- 2. Poem should not be any longer than 7 minutes.
- 3. Topic of the poem is the option of the participant.
- 4. No visual aids or sound effects may be used.
- 5. No costumes allowed.
- 6. Poems must be memorized. Notes are not allowed.
- 7. Ties will be broken by the judges.
- 8. The Judges Decision will be final.

<u>Awards</u>

First through fifth place will be awarded in each age group.

- 1. **Scores** Assign numbers between ranges <u>Excellent:</u> 9 to 12; <u>Good:</u> 5 to 8; and Poor: 1 to 4.
- 2. **Knowledge of Poem** Very important. The speaker should know the poem. The poem must be memorized. Notes cannot be used.
- 3. **Length** Presentation must be less than 7 minutes. Was the length of the presentation appropriate for the poem? Was the length appropriate for the 4-Her and a contest?
- 4. **Presentation** Is the poem presented with enthusiasm and at the proper tempo? Did the speaker use appropriate hand gestures and display eye contact with the audience? Did the presentation motivate the audience?
- 5. **Voice** Could you hear the speaker? Did the speaker speak clearly? Did the speaker go to slow or too fast for the words to be understood?
